#### **Competition Rules**

2017 Junior International Canoe Polo Competition will be run in accordance with the ICF Canoe Polo Competition Rules

#### **Scrutineering Information**

Cosmetic: Boats all the same colour. Numbers on the back of boats and on helmets. Helmets must be the same colour.

Safety: Bumpers new or in good condition. NO TAPE allowed on bumpers.

Helmets: Face guard to reach players jawline.

Boat laminating will be available on the Monday and Tuesday in solid colours at the venue.

### Athlete's Village

There will be toilets and showers available along with changing areas.

#### Access pass and parking

There will be an onsite car park for those competing or supporting competitors at the event.

#### **Boat Storage**

A secure boat storage area with suitable boat racking will be available within a manned gate when open.

#### First Aid

First Aid will be available at all times during the schelduled matches. The NF will advise all participants that emergency medical services will cover only emergency cases and that all participants are responsible to arrange medical insurance policy at their own cost.

#### **Water Safety**

Rescuing in the competition area will be organised during the competition days.

#### **Medical Insurance**

Organising Committee kingly asks all aprticipants of the 2017 Junior International Canoe Polo Competition to ensure medical insurance policy in their respetive countires. All costs above regular first aid and ambulance services are to be covered by this meidcal insurance policy. The organising commitee will not cover any expenses in connection with hospital or dental treatment.

There will be a free campsite with toilets and showers provided onsite beside the pitches. There is a potential to provide tents if required.

Visas are not required for stays off up to 6 months for British Nationals, European Union citizens, non-EU member states of the European Economic Area (Norway, Liechtenstein, Iceland), Switzerland, Australia, New Zealand, Canada and USA.
