ANTIDOPING During the event, anti-doping controls could be carried out by both the NADO and the Ministry of Health. Inspectors from the Anti-doping agency (NAS personnel accredited by NADO - ITALIA) may also be present, with the functions and prerogatives established by art. 23 of Sports Anti-Doping Rules.

The final time-table of each race and the start system will be provided at the end of the accreditations with the delivery of the race program. The races will be in compliance with the ICF Canoe Marathon Rules & Regulations.
