### **ABOUT KRAKOW**



Krakow is also a popular international tourist destination, attracting millions of visitors every year. It is not only a great place to explore the city's monuments, but also a perfect base for visiting other tourist attractions in the region. Some of the most recommended places to visit from Krakow are the Wieliczka Salt Mine, the Auschwitz Nazi concentration camp, the city of Zakopane and the Tatra Mountains, and the Ojcowski National Park. There are many ways to enjoy sightseeing in Krakow, from self-guided tours to free city tours, from special buses to guided tours. There is something for everyone in Krakow, a city to see, visit and "taste".

Krakow is a city in southern Poland that has a lot to offer visitors. It is the second largest and one of the oldest cities in Poland, with a history dating back to the 7th century. It was the capital of Poland until 1596 and the royal residence of Polish kings. It has also been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1978, thanks to its impressive architecture and cultural heritage. Krakow has many attractions that showcase its beauty and charm, such as the Wawel Castle, the Main Market Square, the Cloth Hall, St. Mary's Basilica and the Kazimierz district.















## HOW TO GET TO KRAKOW



Krakow is easily accessible by various means of transportation. It has railway hub where numerous regional, national and international lines converge. It offers bus services to the main European and Polish cities and has its own international airport: John Paul II International Airport in Krakow-Balice.



BY AIR

Krakow-Balice Airport is located in the town of Balice, 11 km from Krakow. The "Balice Ekspres" is the fastest connection between the center of Krakow and the airport. You can also take a bus or a taxi from the airport to the city.

#### BY CAR

You can get to Krakow on the A4 highway (toll). This makes traveling from the west fairly easy. Driving from Warsaw : the easiest route is the S7 express road. The center of Krakow is a parking zone. Drivers pay at parking meters located along the streets of the city center.





#### **BY TRAIN**

All trains arriving in Krakow stop at Krakow Glowny. The station is located near the city center and has connections to other cities in Poland and Europe. You can buy tickets online, at ticket counters or at ticket machines in the station.

#### BY BUS

The PKS (Bus Transport Company) station is centrally located behind the Central Railway Station in Krakow. It offers both domestic and international services. In addition to ticket offices, kiosks, a bar and a PKS information desk, the bus station hall also houses travel agencies selling tickets for international routes.















## **VENUE of the COMPETITION**



Krakow has already hosted two editions of the ICF Canoe Slalom Junior and U23 World Championships in 2016 and 2019, where young athletes from all over the world competed in various categories. The event was a great success and showcased the talent and passion of the next generation of canoe slalom paddlers. Krakow will host two major canoe slalom events in 2023: the Canoe Slalom European Games and the ICF Canoe Slalom Junior and U23 World Championships. The European Games will be held in June 2023 as part of a multisport event in Krakow and Malopolska. The event will bring together the best canoe slalom athletes in Europe to compete for medals and Olympic qualification.



Krakow is a host city for canoe slalom events. as it has an artificial whitewater course on the south bank of the Vistula River. The Krakow-Kolna canoe slalom course is 320 meters long and has a drop of 3.5 meters. It offers different levels of difficulty and features such as waves, holes, eddies and gates. The course is open all year round and has a heated tent that covers the starting pool in winter.



The Junior and U23 World Championships will be held in August 2023 as an event for the future stars of the sport. Both events will take place on the Krakow-Kolna Canoe Slalom course, which will be upgraded and modernized for the occasion. The event will be a great opportunity to enjoy the spectacular sport of canoe slalom and support the young athletes.

#### PRINCIPLES

Entries and accreditation requests for the event must be made by the National Federation using the ICF's online entries system (SDP): <u>https://icf.msl.es/icf/icf.jsp</u>

#### NUMERICAL ENTRIES

You must enter the number of athletes you will be entering in each event through SDP. You must also provide an estimate of the total number of athletes and team officials who will be attending the event with your delegation.

NOMINAL ENTRIES

Nominal Entries close: August 5, 2023 (Saturday)

You must submit the name of each Athlete who will compete in the Event through SDP. You must also submit the names of team officials who will require accreditation for the event. These entries will be used to generate accreditation cards for all teams.

#### REMINDER

Entries or accreditation requests sent directly to the committee or event organizer will NOT be accepted. You must use the SDP to submit your entries and requests.
